WHAT IS PPAP?

PPAP is the automotive industry standard that defines the production part approval process (PPAP) and demonstrates engineering design records and specification requirements are achieved by the supplier's manufacturing process.

PPAP validates a production process by inspecting parts before, during, and after a production run.

PPAP generates data/ information for 18 requirements such as control plan, failure mode effects analysis, flow, dimensional results, engineering approval, and more. All 18 requirements must be completed by Fair-Rite no matter the PPAP level requested.

It is important to note that PPAP is a physical process, it is not paperwork that can be added after a part has been produced or shipped. It is important for Fair Rite to be aware of this requirement prior to quoting or accepting work with this requirement for this reason.
